- James Rogers is an American businessman and financial commentator based in Singapore.
- He was the co-founder of the Quantum Fund and Soros Fund Management which enjoyed fabulously successful returns. Rogers is now the Chairman of Beeland Interests, Inc. and created the Rogers International Commodity Index (RICI).
- In 1990-92, Jim set out to fulfil a lifelong dream: motorcycling 100,000 miles across six continents – an achievement that landed him in the Guinness Book of World Records. In 1999, Jim embarked on a Millennium Adventure, travelling around the world for 3 years, passing through 116 countries and covering more than 245,000 kilometres – setting yet another Guinness World Record in the process.
- His adventures were not just travel per se but journeys to learn about the world's developing countries and investment markets first-hand; as a private investor he constantly analysed countries through which he travelled for investment ideas, striving to get to the heart of what drives successful nations and economies.

- Author of six books: *Investment Biker* (1994); *Adventure Capitalist* (2003); *Hot Commodities* (2005); and *A Bull in China* (2007), *A Gift to My Children* (2009) and *Street Smarts: Adventures on the Road and in the Markets* (2013).

Jim Rogers - Personal information

- In April 2019, Jim Rogers received the honorary Ph.D. from the Pusan National University.
- He was previously a visiting professor of Finance at Columbia University Graduate School.
- He co-founded a global investment partnership, The Quantum Fund, in the 1970s which made a 4200% return over ten years while the S&P rose only 47%. He then 'retired' aged 37.
- His first job on Wall Street was at Dominick & Dominick. In 1970, Rogers joined investment bank Arnhold and S. Bleichroder, where he worked with George Soros.
- Jim has a bachelor's degree in History from Yale University and another in Philosophy, Politics and Economics at Oxford University.
